

Liberal Arts Graduation Requirements:

For students who started at RISD before 9/1/2024
and transfer students who started at RISD anytime during or before AY 2024-25

Notes

Courses designated as LAEL or SCI do not count toward HPSS, THAD, or LAS credit.

Courses in business or engineering are typically not accepted for Liberal Arts credit unless they are taught from a liberal arts perspective (e.g. sociology of business).

Theory + History of Art + Design THAD

12 credits required

THAD courses include the theory and history of art and design.
